The regular meeting of the Baxley City Council was held on February 14, 2024 at 8:30 a.m., with the following members present: Mayor Tim Varnadore, Mayor Pro Tem Mickey Bass, Councilmembers: Santina Fryer, Betty Livingston, David Gore, Adam Thomas, and Ora Hall.
