Appling Leads is a six-month adult leadership program developed through a partnership between the Baxley-Appling County Chamber of Commerce and the J.W. Fanning Institute for Leadership Development at the University of Georgia. Appling Leads exists to engage a diverse team of community members, empowered to commit to Appling County, and educated in leadership practices. The program targets individuals who represent all segments of the community, and have a sincere interest in building their leadership skills to better serve their self, employer and/or community.

Tuition is \$370 per participant. Tuition covers all sessions, transportation, meals and overnight accommodations. A \$100 deposit is due with application and the balance of \$200 must be paid by orientation day, January 19, 2024. A limited number of scholarships are available. Please inquire with our office to discuss scholarship options.
